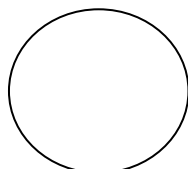

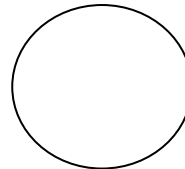

If any evidence of infection/inflammation, document and refer immediately.
If punctuate keratitis, increase lubrication.

Patient Advice

1. Can go back to normal after 28 days from surgery
2. If has premium intraocular lens:
Multifocal expect N6-N10
Extended Depth of Focus expect N10-N14
3. Even with premium lens, expect to be out of glasses 80% of time for Extended Depth of Focus & Multifocal expect 90% of time
4. Glasses can be prescribed at 1 month visit
5. Lubrication may be needed up to 3 months.
