Car



From the M42, exit at junction 5 for the A41 (Solihull-by- Pass). Take a left on the B425 (Lode Lane) which leads to Midland Eye which is on the left.

Limited free parking can be accessed via Grove Road.

Train



Solihull station is approximately a 20 minute walk or there are a number of buses you can take that will stop nearby. Both the 966 and the X12 buses stop approximately 50 meters from the Clinic. Birmingham International Train Station is a 10 minute taxi journey to us.

Bus



The bus stop is situated approximately 50 meters from the Clinic for the 58, 71A, 73, X12 and 966.

Plane



You can fly into Birmingham International Airport, then take a 10 minute taxi journey to the Clinic.
